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## ADDITIONAL COSTS/FEES:

The costs/fees incurred to implement or use Evolution EHR 3.0 include:

- For new customers, a one-time license fee for Evolution Core and Optional Modules including Evolution HER, applies.
- Implementation fees includes one-time service fee for installation, configuration, training and operational support.
- Established customers do not pay implementation fees for Evolution EHR v.3.0 up-date unless out of scope services (additional training and support hours) are requested in which cases a one-time service fee may apply.
- Established and new customers may pay for customization or modifications requests with an initial and/or on-going monthly fee.
- Third party applications for specific functions as; e-prescribing, medical vocabularies, drugs clinical checking, decision support tools, patient portal and health information exchange capabilities, requires an active annual license fee, a maintenance fee or transaction fee. Those agreements are included within the master agreement contract with Infomedika.

- Monthly updates are provided.
- Requires an annual license fee.

### Dr. First for e-prescribing function

- Evolution EHR 3.0 integrates seamlessly with R'Copia to provide a safe and efficient e-prescribing functionality.
- Requires a one-time license fee and a recurring maintenance fee by institution or provider in the ambulatory setting.
- R'copia is also a certified technology required to complement Evolution-EHR for attestation purposes.

## CONTRACTUAL LIMITATIONS:

- The use of Evolution EHR requires an active Master Software Agreement with Infomedika, Inc. An associated maintenance agreement is also required for One-time license. All licenses are described in a Program Description Annex that includes the name, fees and owner of the license.
- For third party products an annual license fee may apply.
- Other Third-party integration capabilities that the products previously describe, must be verified with Infomedika.
- No other contract limitations are recognized.

## TECHNICAL OR PRACTICAL LIMITATIONS:

- Evolution EHR v.3.0 requires Microsoft SQL Enterprise Edition 2014 (64 bit).
- Internet connectivity is required.
- Monthly up-dates for drug files is recommended.
