# Sage 100 Supported Versions

## Finding Your Sage 100 Version

Knowing your Sage 100 version is key for troubleshooting and staying up-to-date. If you can log in, it's easy: just go to the "Help" menu and select "About Sage 100." This will show you the full version details, like "Sage 100c Standard 2016 (Version 5.30.3.0)."

If you can't log in, you can still find the base version. Look for the "status.flp" file in your "..\MAS90\Home" directory. Open it with a text editor like Notepad. The file shows the System Setup (SS) version, which corresponds to the base Sage 100 version. For example, "7.10" means Sage 100 2022, and "5.30" means Sage 100 2016. Keep in mind, this only shows the base version and not any product updates or fixes.
